The Directorate of Educational Research & Training, Meghalaya, Shillong invites Application from Candidates for **National Talent Search Examination (NTSE)-State Level Screening Test (Stage-1) for Class X** for the year 2021-2022 which will be held on the **15th January, 2022 (SATURDAY)** to select 50 students (State Quota allotted by NCERT, New Delhi). Students currently studying in Class X from any recognized Schools of Meghalaya are eligible to appear the above said Examination. Students registered under Open Distance Learning (ODL) will also be eligible for scholarship, provided the students is below the age of 18 years (as on 1st July of the particular year), the student is not employed and she/he is appearing in Class X Examination for the first time.

Students who are selected/ recommended from Stage-1 Examination will be eligible to appear for **Stage-II Examination** to be conducted by NCERT on the **12th June, 2022 (SUNDAY)**.
Stage-1 Examination at State Level will comprise of two papers i.e.:-
