Eligibility:

- Candidates currently studying in Class VIII in State Government, Government Aided and Local Body Schools only.
- Candidates should have scored atleast 55% (50% for SC/ST) marks in Class VII Promotion Examination.
- Candidates studying in Kendriya Vidyalayas, Jawahar Navodayas and Residential Schools run by Central and State Government are not entitled for Scholarship under NMMS Scheme.
