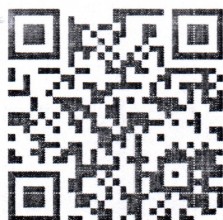

The Directorate of Educational Research & Training (DERT) is pleased to inform all the Schools in Meghalaya that the **Meghalaya Learning Enhancement Programme (M-LEP) DIKSHA Course**, which is a self-paced Professional Development Course for teachers, is available on the **Meghalaya DIKSHA** platform from 15th June 2026. The course has been developed by the Directorate of Educational Research & Training (DERT), Meghalaya, in collaboration with the Reach to Teach Foundation, with the objective of building teachers' capacity in Competency-Based Education and effective classroom implementation of M-LEP as recommended by NEP 2020 and PARAKH.

To strengthen Meghalaya's performance in the Performance Grading Index (PGI), PARAKH Rashtriya Sarvekshan (PRS), and other national assessments, **this course—together with the M-LEP programme**—will equip teachers to understand competency-based education, apply competencies in classroom practice, assess learners effectively and plan instruction accordingly. In this connection, all District School Education Officers, SDSEOs and DMCs are hereby requested to ensure that **all the schools under their jurisdiction – enrol in and successfully complete the M-LEP DIKSHA Course** within the stipulated period, i.e., **15th June 2026 to 31st August 2026**.

About the Course:

- **Platform:** DIKSHA Courses App – accessible on mobile or web, anytime and anywhere.
- **Duration:** 120 minutes (self-paced; flexible and convenient).
- **Certification:** Completion certificates are automatically generated upon successful completion of the course.
- **Enrolment & Completion Window:** 15th June 2026 – 31st August 2026.

Course Objectives – What Teachers Will Learn:

- Understand what, why and how of Competency Based Education.
- How to implement M-LEP in classrooms along with the textbooks.
- Innovative classroom strategies and lesson plan for English, Maths & Science.


