Advertisement for Different types of Scholarships under D.H.T.E Office Meghalaya, Shillong

ADVERTISEMENT

Applications in prescribed format are invited from the students who are permanent residents in the state of Meghalaya studying within and outside the State for the year 2012-2013.

1. Post Matric Scholarship for Scheduled Tribe students who are pursuing higher studies in different courses from class XI to Post-Graduation. Annual income of Parents for Scheduled Tribe Students should not exceed ₹2.00 Lakhs p.a
2. Post Matric Scholarship for Scheduled Caste students who are pursuing higher studies in different courses from class XI to Post-Graduation. Annual income of Parents for Scheduled Caste students should not exceed ₹2.00 Lakhs p.a
3. North Eastern Council Book Grant and stipend for the General, SC/ST students studying in Vocational/Technical courses inside and outside the state of Meghalaya. The Students should produce P.R.C obtained from the Dy. Commissioner of the district in which the candidate is a permanent resident of Meghalaya alongwith their relevant documents. Students who secure marks 50% above for Scheduled Tribe/Scheduled Caste and 55% above for General are eligible to apply for this Scholarship.
4. Free Studentship Scholarship for Scheduled Tribe/Scheduled Caste students who are pursuing higher studies in different courses from class XI to Post-Graduation. Students who failed in the previous year and also those students whose Annual income of Parents exceeds the amount mentioned at Sl. No. 1 and 2 above are eligible to apply for this scholarship
5. Book Grant Scholarship for Scheduled Tribe/Scheduled Caste students who are pursuing higher studies in different courses from class XI to Post-Graduation and who secured marks 60% above are eligible to apply for the Book Grant Scholarship.
6. Post Graduate Research Scholarship for the students of Meghalaya (SC/CT and General) who are doing research courses under University or Research Institutions for M.Phil or Ph.D and who secured marks 50% above are eligible to apply for the Scholarship.
7. Award of Border Area Scholarship are invited from students belonging to SC/ST in the state of Meghalaya pursuing Higher Post Matric Studies within and outside the State during the current year 2011-2012.

Eligibility:

- a) The student should be a permanent resident of Meghalaya in Border Area.
- b) He/She belongs to SC/ST Community of the State of Meghalaya.
- c) He/She is pursuing a regular Course of Studies in any recognized institution.
- d) His/Her guardian/ parent are Citizens of India.
- e) That He/She is not employed in any Service under the Government of any Non- Government establishment.
- f) He/She is not a repeater in the same class for more than once.

Students studying within the state are to collect the forms (Fresh and Renewal) from the institutions where they are studying. Students studying outside the state may collect the forms from the Office of the undersigned, Room No. 206(B) from 01.06.2012 onward.

All the Principals submitting the application forms should submit along with the soft copy.

The last date of submission of application forms will be on or before the 31.07.2012. No application form will be entertained after the above specified date.
