Applications are to be submitted online through <https://rpa.meghalaya.gov.in>. Applications received through any other mode will not be accepted and will be summarily rejected.

The link will be active from 28th October 2025 and the last date for submission of on-line applications through <https://rpa.meghalaya.gov.in> is on 27th November 2025 at 23:59 hours after which the link will be disabled.

PARA 1: LISTS OF POSTS

*****IMPORTANT:** It is mandatory for the applicants to have acquired the requisite educational qualification(s) prescribed for the post, as on the last date fixed for submission of applications.

The date on which an applicant is deemed to have acquired the requisite educational qualification shall be the Date on which the result of the last examination for such qualification/degree is declared by the Universities/Board/Institutions.

PARA 2: CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY:

A. For the posts at sl No 1:

Minimum qualification: B. E. / B. Tech. / B. S. in relevant discipline with First Class or equivalent.

B. For the posts at sl No 2 & 3:

Minimum qualification: B. E. / B. Tech. / B. S. and M. E. / M. Tech. / M. S. or Integrated M. Tech. in relevant branch with first class or equivalent in any one of the degrees

PARA 3: AGE & RELAXATION:

Upper age limit is 32 years as on 01.10.2025 with usual relaxation of 5 years for SC/ST candidate. There is no age limit for candidates who are already in Meghalaya Government service provided they entered services within the prescribed age limit.

Notes:

The date of birth to be accepted by MERB is as entered in the Matriculation/ Secondary School Leaving Certificate/ or a Certificate recognized by an Indian University as equivalent to Matriculation or an extract from the official Registers duly Certified by the proper

authority of the Board of School Education. Proof other than these, will not be accepted by the MEGHALAYA EDUCATION RECRUITMENT BOARD (MERB).

PARA 4: FEE NON-REFUNDABLE.

Fee @ prescribed in the Table below is required to be paid through On-line mode.

PARA 5: PAYMENT OF APPLICATION FEES

Candidates who wish to apply may pay the application fees using any one the following mode of payment only:-

Kindly note that an additional amount in the form of Bank's commission may be applicable depending upon the mode of payment. The amount once deposited shall not be refunded or adjusted against any other purpose.

PARA 6: INSTRUCTIONS

I. Applicants are advised to apply well in advance without waiting for the closing date.

II. Candidate must appear for the Interview at his/ her own expenses.

Admission at all stages of the recruitment process for which the candidates are admitted by the MERB will be purely provisional and is subject to satisfying the prescribed eligibility conditions. If, on verification at any stage of the recruitment process, it is found that applicants/ candidates do not fulfill any of the eligibility conditions, their candidature for the post will automatically be cancelled by the MERB without notice.

PARA 7: METHOD OF SELECTION

The selection/ recommendation of suitable candidates against the vacancies notified in the Advertisement shall be made by the **MERB** through any of the following processes:

I. Written Examination (MCQ format) followed by Personal Interview.

II. Short-listing of candidates followed by Personal Interview. The Short-listing of candidates will be based on the MERB Short-listing norms, updated from time to time.

***It will be the discretion of the **MERB** to cancel any processes mentioned above if found that illegal/unfair means have been adopted during the conduct of the recruitment process.

*** Only candidates who have produced all the required documents in original relating to their education's qualification, date of birth, caste, community and other certificates wherever required and prescribed by Rules will be deemed qualified to be called for Personal Interview.

PARA 8: DEBARMENT

(a) Candidates should make sure of their eligibility for the post applied for and that the declaration made by them in the format of application regarding their eligibility is correct in all respects. Any candidate furnishing incorrect information or making false declaration regarding his/her eligibility at any stage or suppressing any information is liable TO BE DEBARRED FROM APPEARING FOR ANY OF THE EXAMINATIONS CONDUCTED BY THE **MERB**, and summarily their candidature for this recruitment will be rejected.

(b) The **MERB** is vested with the constitutional duty of conducting recruitment and selection as per rules by duly maintaining utmost secrecy and confidentiality in this process and any

attempt by anyone causing or likely to cause breach of this constitutional duty in such manner or by such action so as to violate or likely to violate the fair practices followed and ensured by the **MERB** will be sufficient cause for rendering such questionable means as ground for debarment.

(c) If any candidate is or has been found impersonating or procuring impersonation by any person or resorting to any other irregular or improper means in connection with or improper means in connection with his/her candidature for selection or obtaining support of candidature by any means, such a candidate may in addition to rendering himself/herself liable to criminal prosecution, will be liable to be debarred permanently from any exam or selection held by the Meghalaya Education Recruitment Board.
